***Bobby Adams***, music director and principal conductor of the Southern Winds Wind Symphony, is Director of Bands and Professor of Music Education at the Stetson University School of Music. Appointed to the Stetson faculty in 1987, Dr. Adams conducts the University Symphonic Band, and teaches courses in advanced conducting and instrumental music education.

Prior to his appointment at Stetson, Dr. Adams taught in the public school system in Indiana and Florida for twenty-five years. In Florida he was Director of Bands at North Ft. Myers High School, Bayshore High School (Bradenton), and Leon High School (Tallahassee). He holds a Bachelor of Arts degree from Morehead State University (KY), a Master of Music Education degree from Murray State University (KY), and a PhD in Music Education from Florida State University.

Dr. Adams is currently Past President of the National Band Association. He is a past-president of the College Band Directors National Association – Southern Division, the Music Educators National Association – Southern Division, the Florida Music Educators Association, and the Florida Bandmasters Association. Dr. Adams is also Chairman of the Board of Directors of the FBA Hall of Fame. He is a member of Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, Phi Beta Mu, World Association for Symphonic Bands and Ensembles and the American Bandmasters Association. Dr. Adams has been inducted into the FMEA Hall of Fame, FBA Hall of Fame and the FBA Roll of Distinction.

***Southern Winds***, a symphonic band comprised of musicians from the Greater Orlando area, had its inaugural performance on November 10, 2001, as a part of the Florida Bandmasters Association Hall of Fame activities. Guest conductors for that concert included FBA Hall of Fame members Charles Quarmby, Andrew J. Crew, F. Lewis Jones, Fred Humphreys and FBA Executive Director Duane Hendon. Southern Winds was formed to provide a performance medium for area band directors and other musicians, including the Stetson University wind faculty, elementary and choral music teachers, professional players, local businesspeople and other professionals, including our very own dentist. While most members are from the Central Florida area, some come from as far away as Jacksonville, St. Petersburg and Miami. Since the inaugural concert in Elizabeth Hall on the campus of Stetson University, Southern Winds has performed annually for the Florida Bandmasters Association Role of Distinction concerts and has appeared regularly at the Florida Bandmasters Association summer convention. Most recently Southern Winds had the privilege of performing at the 2008 FMEA In-Service Clinic-Conference. Southern Winds performs a wide range of repertoire ranging from early classical works to music by contemporary composers, large symphonic works to chamber pieces and orchestral transcriptions to original works for band. In addition, the ensemble has presented concerts at various schools throughout Florida, including programs in the style of John Philip Sousa.
